Lorrie reports we are at \$38k this year. \$31k so far has been spent on teacher grants. We have set aside some money for scholarships and the college resource room.

Rob reports that Plant is changing and adding some courses for next year.

Testing will begin soon – FSA, EOC, and SAT. District is working on removing EOCs for those classes that have AP exams as well.
